The following chart shows how *The Lives of the Prophets/Stories of the Prophets* eliminates filial language from the audio text in its account of Jesus Christ's life. It is helpful to note that the transcript of the *Jesus Film* was used and modified. It is also quite striking that the parable of the Prodigal Son, with its strong inference of the Father and son relationship that believers enter into has been completely eliminated although it is in the *Jesus Film*. - Adam Simnowitz
